

**HOUR 3 REPORT - TROUBLE FOR THE #100!**



**M6 GT3**

SP9 CLASS



Trouble has hit the Pro-Am #100 M6 GT3 car in the third hour of racing at the Nordschleife, with Mario von Buhlen, who had just taken over the car from Andreas Ziegler, crashing the car out at the Brünchen corner.

The car is still stranded on the circuit, but should be repairable should it be possible to return it to the pit lane.





Meanwhile, the Pro driven #101 car is running in 18th, after Mikkel Jensen pitted to hand over the car to David Pittard after 16 laps.

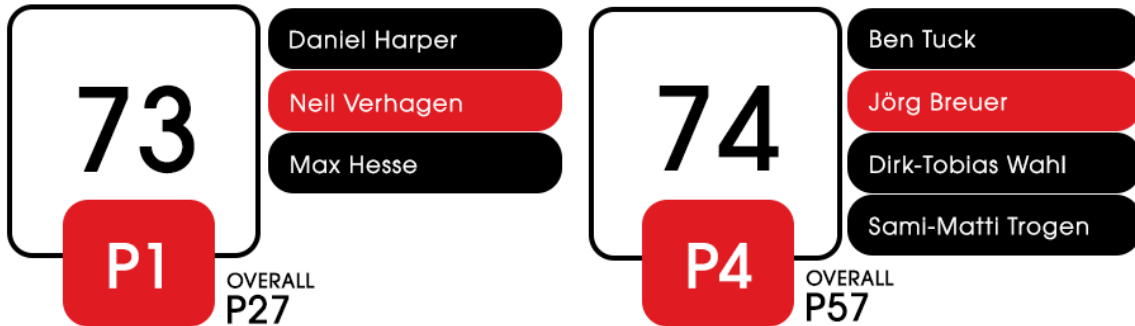
It was a good stint from Jensen, though opting for a lower tyre pressure setting backfired when it began to rain again around the Nordschleife section of the circuit.

Mikkel Jensen (DEN), #101 BMW M6 GT3, said:

*We went too low on the pressure. We saw the rain start to dissipate before my stint, so we went low on the pressure, but then the rain came back again – so we were pretty slow on the first half of my stint, but as the rain went away again we got a bit quicker.*



SP8T CLASS
