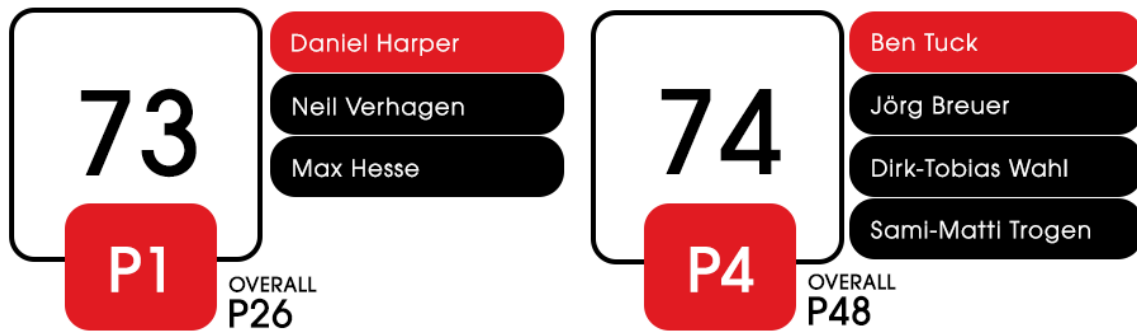
Mario von Buhlen is back behind the wheel of the car, as it's now back on circuit, albeit 29 laps down.
