

HOUR 16 REPORT - THE RACE WILL RESUME AT 8AM

SP9 CLASS



Following an overnight stoppage, it's now been confirmed that the 2020 Nürburgring 24 Hour race will restart this morning, behind the safety car, at 08:00 CEST.

The sun is just about to rise over the Eifel Mountains, and though it's still lightly raining, conditions are deemed safe enough for a restart, and it's expected to dry out over the course of the morning.

The #101 car of Christian Krognès-David Pittard-Mikkel Jensen-Jordan Pepper will restart the race from 13th position, on the inside of Row 7 on the restart grid, while



the repaired #100 car of Henry Walkenhorst-Andreas Ziegler-Friedrich von Buhlen-Mario von Buhlen will start from 93rd on the grid - following three overnight retirements - on the inside of the 47th row on the grid.

SP8T CLASS



At the restart, the #73 BMW Junior Team M4 GT4 will lead the SP8T class, 26th overall, while the #74 is a little further down the order in fourth, 48th overall.
